Are you or your parent a veteran or surviving spouse of a veteran:

- who served at least 90 days of consecutive active military service, one day served during wartime?
- who has been discharged in any way other than dishonorable?
- who is permanently disabled or at least age 65?
- who now, or will in the near future, need assistance with daily activities?

U.S. Service Benefits will assess your eligibility for V.A. benefits (Improved pension and Aid and Attendance benefits), and assist you though the application process, at no cost to you. Eligibility includes seniors at home, in assisted living, or in a nursing home! Family caregivers may even qualify as a home aide.
